
FUNERAL OF FIRE VICTIMS.

The Final, Sad Scene in Newark's Tenement Disaster.

NEWARK, N. J., March 16.—The funeral of the fifteen victims of the tenement house fire, at Morris and Fourteenth Avenues, Monday morning, took place to-day from St. Peter's Church, in this city. The large edifice was crowded to the doors. High mass was celebrated at 10 o'clock, and at the conclusion of the service the funeral procession moved to the Cemetery of the Holy Sepulchre, where the burials took place.

Every Italian society was represented in the procession, which was headed by a squad of policemen and a military band.
